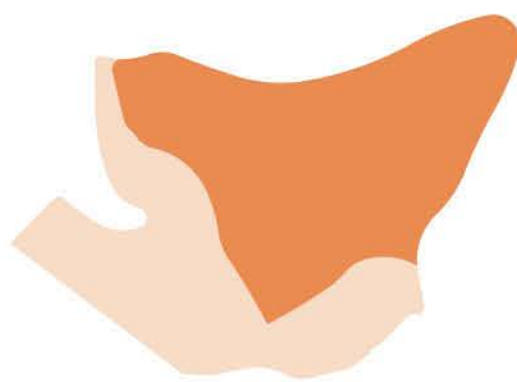
Work with your group to throw out all your best ideas for park names in each category! When you feel you have enough, try to agree on the three top choices.

 → Are there meaningful historical or cultural events or phrases that come to mind?

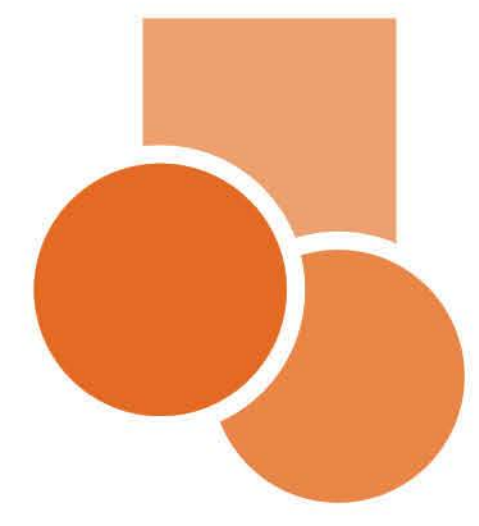
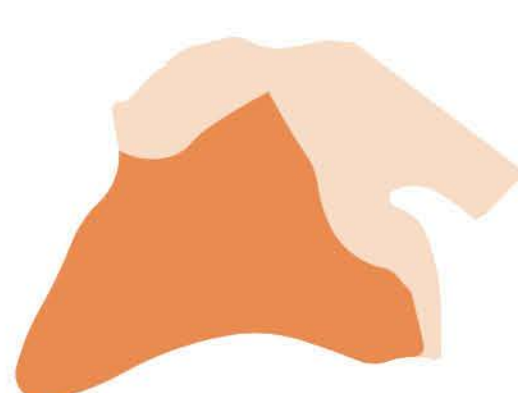
